- Ensure that the box at the beginning of the entry form is checked to indicate that they wish to be considered for Nationals. IF THAT BOX IS NOT CHECKED YOUR NAME WILL NOT APPEAR ON THE LIST FOR CONSIDERATION.

Ensemble Performance

Eligible ensembles may be recommended to **National Music Festival Ensemble Classes** (recorded stream) by the adjudicator(s) at the Provincial finals.
