**Monette Gould**  
**Vocal Adjudicator**

Monette Gould is a soprano with many years of professional experience as a performer and teacher. Born in New Brunswick, she later moved to Toronto, Ontario to pursue her studies in music. Monette holds two performance diplomas, an A.R.C.T. and a Performance Licentiate, from The Royal Conservatory of Music, and an Opera Performance Diploma from the University of Toronto. After completing her studies Monette returned to New Brunswick to teach voice at Mount Allison University for a period of 20 years. She also taught for 10 years at l'Université de Moncton. She has privately for 35 years and worked with high school students who want to prepare to enter university music programs.

Monette was the founder and director of the well-known Voce dell'Anima Choir. She has also taught courses such as Diction for Singers, Sight-singing, Dictation and Aural Skills, and has given workshops on Stage Presence, How to Practice, Options in Music, and How to Set Up a Private Studio. She is highly regarded and is in very high demand as an adjudicator and clinician across the country. Many of her students have excelled, continuing on to some of the best international graduate programs, and winning prestigious awards, competitions and scholarships.

Monette continues to sing and coach, but when she is not doing music, she is a certified funeral celebrant. She also opened her own grooming business called Monette's Gentle Grooming. She is also very busy as the vice president of the Greater Moncton Music Festival. She also enjoys spending time with her little fur babies, Merle, Olive, Lucy, Jack and Charlie.



## **Katherine Dowling**

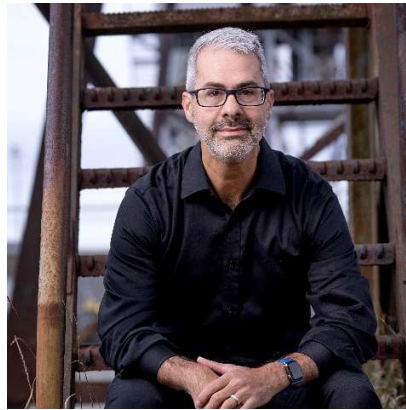
### **Piano Adjudicator**

Praised by the *New York Times* for her “crystalline performances, gestural expressiveness, and careful attention to color”, and by the *Boston Globe* for her “effortless incisiveness”, award-winning “tour-de-force” (*OpusKlassiek*, *Berkshire Eagle*) pianist Katherine Dowling performs across the Americas and Europe as a soloist and chamber musician. Katherine is familiar to audiences through regular appearances at Canada’s major music festivals and concert series, including Ottawa Chamberfest and Stratford Summer Music.

Recent highlights include her recital debuts in Vienna, The Hague, and Rio de Janeiro. She is further familiar to audiences as an artist of the Tanglewood Music Centre, the Aldeburgh Festival (U.K.), the IMS Prussia Cove (U.K), the Orlando Festival (Netherlands), the Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity, and the Eckhardt-Grammaté National Music Competition.

Alongside the gems of the classical piano repertoire, she has premiered over one hundred new works by composers including Louis Andriessen and John Harbison. As a soloist, and as a member of the chamber ensemble Gruppo Montebello, Katherine appears on nine critically-acclaimed recordings on the Etcetera label. Her debut solo album “Awake and Dreaming - piano music of Alice Ping-Yee Ho” was nominated for “Classical Album of the Year (Solo Artist)” at the 2026 JUNO Awards. Her performances have been broadcast on the BBC (United Kingdom), National Radio 4 (Netherlands), CBC, and Radio Canada.

Katherine lives in Sackville, New Brunswick, with her husband and baby son. She is Professor of Piano at Mount Allison University, having previously served as Professor at York University (Toronto) and University of Regina. She credits her own teachers, Gilbert Kalish, Henri-Paul Sicsic, and Janice Elliot-Denike, and conductors Oliver Knussen and Henk Guitart, as the major influences in her musical life. She loves adjudicating, and has done nearly one hundred festivals, ranging from the National Finals of the Canadian Music Competition and the Canada West Finals, to the smallest regional festivals (such as Leflèche, SK - population 324!).



## **Tristan De Borba** **Instrumental Adjudicator**

Tristan De Borba is a classical and contemporary saxophonist and conductor and is quickly gaining a reputation as an innovative and engaging musician.

He is Associate Professor at Acadia University in Wolfville, Nova Scotia where he teaches saxophone, conducts the Acadia University Symphonic Band and String Orchestra, and teaches musicianship.

Tristan has a strong interest in the music of our time. He is a member of the Alkali Collective, a Halifax-based new music ensemble dedicated to the creation, performance, documentation, and educational outreach of 21<sup>st</sup> century music. Tristan also performs with the Strum-De Borba duo with fellow saxophonist Nicole Strum. The duo recently released *Heavy Stones* by composer Robert Humber. This five-movement duo for two baritone saxophone stretches the technical and musical possibilities of the baritone saxophone. Tristan is a founding member of the Brogue Saxophone Quartet which has performed extensively throughout the maritime provinces since 2013. As a soloist, Tristan's recording of Derek Charke's *Wired and Wound* with pianist Simon Docking can be found on the ECMA nominated recording "Live Wired" (Centrediscs, 2015). He also appears as saxophone soloist on "In the Wide Awe of Wisdom" featuring the choral music of Paul Halley (Pelagos, 2017). In 2021, Alongside pianist Mary Castello, Tristan released a [video recording](#) of Fernande Decruck's *Sonata* and William Grant Still's *Romance*. As a conductor and educator, Tristan is increasingly in demand as a clinician and adjudicator of bands and orchestras.

Dr. Tristan De Borba earned a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Toronto and a Master of Music degree from the University of British Columbia. When taking a break from a busy performing and teaching career, Tristan can be found alongside his wife Sara and their dogs Lua and Sasi exploring beautiful Nova Scotia.
